HOW TO ENROLL

To enroll as a new user:

Call Discovery Education at 1-800-323-9084 and ask for support for Alabama schools for Unitedstreaming. They will provide you with a passcode that will enable you to enroll. After you have received your passcode, log on to APTPLUS.org, click on "Existing User" next to Unitedstreaming, type the passcode into the appropriate boxes (bottom right) and follow the prompts to create a User Name and password. When you have completed the enrollment process, your User Name and password will provide future entry into the service.

To retrieve forgotten User Name and/or Password:

Call Unitedstreaming at 1-800-323-9084 and ask for support for Alabama schools. Tell Christy or Matt your situation and they can provide you with your User Name and they can email your password to you.
